# Cleaning and disinfecting touchscreens

### On Systam Respa self-service kiosks

This guide describes the recommended cleaning and disinfecting procedure for touchscreens in our self-service kiosks.

Cleaning and disinfecting are two steps. Cleaning removes dirt, grease, dust and other contaminants. Disinfecting is a separate process that uses a chemical designed to destroy bacteria.

#### Cleaning

- 1. Please note, that cleaning the screen may cause unintended touches in the application.
- **2.** Do not get liquids inside the unit. Do not spray the screeen directly. Instead, use wet wipes or a dampened cloth with the excess moisture squeezed off.
- **3.** Select only non-abrasive cleaning wipes or cloths to avoid scratching touchscreens.
- **4.** Wipe the surfaces and allow them to dry.

#### Disinfecting

- 1. Dampen a new clean, non-abrasive cloth with a disinfectant\*. Ensure excess liquid is squeezed from the cloth. You may also use pre-dampened wipes.
- **2.** Read the manufacturer's instructions carefully. Many manufacturers require the surface to remain wet for a few minutes, so continuous wiping might be required.
- **3.** Disinfect the surfaces by wiping them with the cloth or wipe, and allow the surface to dry.

\*Recommended disinfectant solutions are for example: Household bleach solution (1 dl / 5 litres of water) Isopropyl alcohol (≤70% alcohol)

#### Do NOT use the following materials when cleaning/disinfecting your touchscreen

- Alcohol at concentration > 70%
- Methyl or ethyl > 35%
- Thinner or benzine
- Strong alkali lyes
- Strong solvents
- Acids
- Detergents with fluoride
- Detergents with ammonia at concentration > 1.6%
- Abrasive cleaners
- Detergents with abrasives
- Formula 409
- Steel wool
- Sponges with abrasives
- Steel blades
